Job Summary

The Supply Chain Supervisor is responsible for supervising the customer service, procurement and warehouse teams. They will be accountable for all supply activities from customer order intake through parts delivery of the Kansas City's entity. - Seek to negotiate best-price contracts to increase business revenue and effectively control the flow of materials from various suppliers
- Identify, develop and manage effective relationships with existing and potential suppliers of goods and services to meet the established cost, quality and delivery targets
- Coordinates warehouse and transport activities to meet customer target delivery dates
- Manages inbound and outbound scheduling, pickups and all requirements related to the receipt/release of goods, reconciliation, and claims.
- Collaborate with other departments such as procurement, engineering and quality assurance to identify or qualify new suppliers
- Analyze inventories to determine how to increase inventory turns, reduce waste or optimize customer service
