The test was carried out based on the formulation, the safety data sheets of the respective products and the indicated intended use.

The product was produced in compliance with the generally approved technical rules, HACCP, QM, safety data sheets and hygiene regulations. Confirmed by an inspection carried out by us on 21.12.2022.

The intended purpose of the product is stated in the declaration. The products must be stored according to the specified conditions and the transport temperatures must be adhered to. All products are marked with a best before date and contain a batch identification for traceability.

The present certificate is valid for the specified period of use under the relevant EU and national regulations currently in force, laws, directives and standards according to the Foodstuffs and Consumer Goods Act.

The product must not be applied to regenerated cellulose film with direct food contact.
